Show Rules:

1. This show is to be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA, and filing an entry indicates acceptance of the same.
2. The JCRB will not be responsible for loss from Fire, Theft, Accidents or Providential Destruction. Every precaution will be taken to prevent the same.
3. Specials, received too late for listing, will be posted in the showroom.
4. The club reserves the right to substitute another judge, in case of unavailability of the first selection.
5. ENTRY FEE: Single rabbit - \$3. Fur/wool entries \$2.00. (OPEN & YOUTH).
6. Fur entries must be labeled if they are to be Breed or General fur class. Fur entries are shown in their BREED class.
7. This will be a carrying case show only. ALL cases MUST BE solid bottomed.
8. ALL stock must be permanently and LEGIBLY tattooed in the left ear.
9. All rabbits for Open and Youth must be in the showroom by 8:00 am.
10. Any rabbit showing signs of sickness or disease will be denied show space or asked to leave at the discretion of the show superintendents. No breeding is allowed on the premises without consent of the owner/owners and show superintendents.
11. You are responsible for getting your rabbits to the judges table. No adults are to place rabbits on the Youth judging tables. Classes will be called three (3) times only from the judging tables. No entry fees will be refunded.
- 12. There will be NO changes allowed to entries after the breed goes up for judging. All ear number and other changes must be made with the show secretary PRIOR TO THE BREED BEING JUDGED. Any remark cards that do not match the entry form will be disqualified and no refund given.**
13. Ribbons for placements of 1st thru 3rd will be available for youth. No ribbons will be mailed. BOB/BOS Rosettes will be available for Open and Youth.
14. An ARBA registrar will be available.
15. No shipped in rabbits will be accepted.
16. ARBA entry forms and remark cards or computer software forms will be accepted.
17. Any breed sanctioned this year having fewer than ten (10) rabbits shown may not be sanctioned next year unless a breeder sponsors the sanction fees.
18. All vendors selling items must have the approval of the JCRB prior to setting up in the showroom.
19. The ARBA host club reserves the right to refuse entries from all locations within 150 miles which has a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within the past 60 days of the entry deadline.
20. The host club is not responsible for catalog errors or omissions.
21. Parents: You are responsible for your children and their actions while visiting the Johnson County Fairgrounds. Therefore, if your child damages property; you are responsible for its replacement.
